Miller Plaza Improvements

Construction period: January to April 2019

Miller Plaza, a beloved public space in Downtown Chattanooga located at 850 Market Street, is currently under renovation to make necessary improvements to the space and better connect the plaza to the newly renovated Miller Park.

Miller Plaza is privately owned and operated by River City Company, and the renovation will cost \$550,000.

Major Changes to Miller Plaza:

- Removal of the round fountain in the center of Miller Plaza that will add further paved area for daily use and events.
- All new lighting in the plaza, not including the inside of the Waterhouse Pavilion.
- Enhanced landscaping.
- Needed repairs to remaining water fall feature on the Cherry Street side of the plaza.
- Enhanced connection and openness to Miller Park across MLK Boulevard.

Additional Information:

- Area in Miller Plaza affected by construction includes from Cherry Street to the Waterhouse Pavilion; this section will be closed to the public during construction.
- The Waterhouse Pavilion will be open during normal operating hours through construction.
- All Miller Plaza tenants will be open during their normal operating hours; not affected by construction.
- Surrounding streets and parking will be unaffected by the construction.
- The full plaza will reopen in April.
